The public tender opening will be on the same date at 12h15 after closing, in the BMC Boardroom in Lobatse. Interested tenderers are at liberty to attend.

1. Tenderers will only be sold to companies who produce valid and certified copy of their tax clearance certificate. (This applies to Botswana registered companies only).
2. Tenders received after the deadline (time and date inclusive) will not be considered nor those submitted by facsimile or email. Tenders may however be couriered to reach the Botswana Meat Commission prior to the closing date and time. The onus shall rest with the tenderer to ensure that the tender is received on time when making use of a courier service. Courier cost will be for the account of the tenderer. BMC takes no responsibility for any couriered tender received after the closing time and date.
